GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE APPLICANTS

1. Applications will be invited for UG Admission (A.Y. 2022-23) ONLY in online mode through Chancellor's Portal (<https://jharkhanduniversities.nic.in>)

Applicants are advised to keep checking University website (www.bbmku.ac.in) as well as college website for important notifications and dates from time to time. For detailed guidelines, please check with University & College Notification. Videos may be checked posted on Chancellor's portal to get help in form filling in UG / PG courses.

2. Admission will be based on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) - As per the provisions of NEP-2020 for the State Universities of Jharkhand (For details see Annexure -I).

3. There are two courses: Regular courses (under NEP-2020) - Application fee Rs. 100/-

: Vocational courses same as previous sessions - Application fee Rs. 250/-

3. Eligibility for regular courses: There are four disciplines-

3.1 Humanities,

3.2 Social Sciences,

3.3 Natural Sciences

3.4 Commerce.

For all disciplines pass marks (33%) is the minimum eligibility to apply. Applicants with Science stream can apply in all disciplines. However, applicants with Arts and Commerce can apply in all disciplines except Natural Science.

4. Eligibility for vocational courses: For details see www.bbmku.ac.in> Regulation>UG> eligibility criteria in Academic section.

5. Subjects offered in Semester I: Six papers are offered in this semester (Three compulsory courses and three optional).

a) CC-1: Language and Communication skill- In this there are two options

i) MIL- Hindi (100 marks)

ii) Non-Hindi (50 marks) + TRL* (50 marks)

* TRL includes Bangla, Sanskrit, Urdu, Khortha and Kudmali. (See Annexure-II)

b) CC-2: Understanding India - compulsory to all

c) CC-3: Health & Wellness, Yoga Education, Sports & Fitness- compulsory to all

d) IRC-1: Applicants have to choose one Introductory courses from the list (College wise and Subject wise as provided in Annexure-II) in Semester-I. Two such courses have to be opted in the next two Semesters, i.e., Sem-2, Sem-3. Out of three only one IRC will be selected for minor subject in Semester-4 & 5.

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Note: In this paper there will be no internal examination and is non practical paper.

e) IVS-1A: After getting Admission to a particular college, one has to choose Introductory Vocational Courses offered by the College. This is a practical subject and is compulsory to all.

f) MJ-1: Applicant has to choose one subject as Major Paper 1 from the list. Major paper once selected will not be changed.

If applicant is interested to apply in more than one major subject, he/she has to apply separate application.

6. Fee structure: For details see Annexure -III.(To be Notified Soon)

7. Reservation Policy: For details see BBMKU UG Regulation

8. Process of filling up online forms.

a) Applicants are advised to use their personal email ID & mobile number /login and advised to remember it (Future communications will be done and EMAIL ID will be used as username for login and mobile number can be used in case any user forget their password).

b) After submission of form, must take a printout to check that all the entries are correct or not. Personal information can be edited by using **Login into your account** to **CHANGE REQUEST** option. (Only these details can be edited Full Name, DOB, Father Name, Mother Name, Gender, Blood Group, Marital Status, Religion, Full Name in Hindi, Father Name in Hindi, and Mother Name in Hindi)

c) Selection criteria, Caste, Board name, major subject and other academic details are not EDITABLE.

So, applicants are strictly advised to check and confirm all the details before submission of the form for Hassel free admission process.

9. Selection will be based on merit (**Note: - Merit Point will be generated as per the details furnished by the students. There will no change / Update in existing details**).If you are claiming selection criteria (Weight age/Merit points) other than merit, you must have the valid documents as mentioned below:

(Note: Acknowledgement receipts in any of the below-mentioned certificates **will not be** accepted, in any case.)

Sl. No.	Type of Certificate	Remarks
1	Valid Caste Certificate (SC/ST/BC-I/BC-II)	Issued from Jharkhand Government ONLY . Caste Certificate from other States will not be admissible.
2	Valid Economically Weaker Section (EWS) applicable for Unreserved Applicants only	Issued from Jharkhand Government ONLY (last One Year) In case of Central Government Employee EWS Certificate (All India/) is also valid for current financial year.
3	NCC/ NSS /ECA	Valid Certificate as mentioned in the application form.
4	Persons with Disability (PWD Quota)	Certificate must be issued from Civil Surgeon Minimum 40% Disability
5	Children/Widows of the eligible Armed Forces Personnel (CW Quota)	Must be issued from Competent Authority
6	Teaching /Non-teaching Wards	Ward case is applicable to siblings or Spouse supported by valid document.
